All major national events for 2020 post April were cancelled despite our best efforts to re-schedule.

All the RC Gliding World Championship category events for 2020 and 2021 were cancelled.

Successful events were flown at Armidale in January, Milang in March and the LSF Easter Scale Rally held over Easter was very well attended and enjoyed fantastic conditions. That was followed by F5J in Horsham late in April and then the wheels started to fall off.

Our 4th and final attempt to hold the 2020 Jerilderie Thermal, F5J and eRES event is now scheduled for November 27/28/29 and we hope that Covid border restrictions do not impact this. Time (and maybe vaccination rates) will tell the story.

Despite the effects of Covid on travel and at times flying at your local club, the level of RC gliding activity and enthusiasm remains positive. Models are being prepared and built, and plans are being made to travel and enjoy the social aspect of flying with friends just as soon as we can.
