



Jerilderie Scale Glider Rally Jerilderie racecourse NSW Easter 29 March – 1 April 2024

The annual Scale Glider Rally will be held at the Jerilderie Racecourse over Easter 2024 under the auspices of LSF Australia.

This is one of the biggest scale glider events on the Australian calendar so if you have any interest in scale gliding, Jerilderie is the place to be from Friday 29 March - Monday 1st April. In 2023 we had great turnout and we are again planning on another great weekend this year.

We have several 120cc and 150cc+ tugs lined up for the larger gliders, but any MAAA member and tow certified pilot offering to do some towing is welcome to help out.

- There is a \$20 registration fee this year.
- Flying is restricted to the event days and designated areas in accordance with our NOTAM.
- You must be a MAAA member to fly at this event.
- Models above 7 kg will need current heavy model certification paperwork.
- At least one heavy model inspector will be present. It will be up to you to arrange certification if needed.
- Tow planes must be restrained (not by hand) for engine startup. We will have plane restraining poles setup.
- The racecourse hall is available for model storage overnight Friday, Saturday and Sunday, and there is a new toilet and shower block available for use.
- Due to limited dining options on Good Friday a BYO BBQ will be held at the Jerilderie Racecourse Hall, Friday evening at the conclusion of flying. There is a large fridge and griller at the Hall's kitchen.
